

Revamped INSPIRE Geoportal Rollout

- The Revamped INSPIRE Geoportal was rolled out on 24 November 2023:
 - Updated to GeoNetwork v4.2.6
 - Some vulnerabilities solved (Known CVE ones + JRC security assessment)
 - Upgraded cloud server to address performance issues
- It includes browsing by HVDs.
- Successfully used for the 2023 Monitoring and Reporting process.
- The harvest console will be re-opened soon.

Geoportal Enhancements

- Objectives:
 - Backend fine tuning & INSPIRE good practices implementation
 - Improved dataset accessibility analysis based on MR Tools experience.
 - OGC API-Features and Data-service Linking Simplification Good Practices.
 - Adding missing functionalities from the Classic INSPIRE Geoportal
 - Exploration of link-checking results + Exportation tool.
 - Automated calculation of the M&R indicators For producing M&R Dashboard page.
- Incorporating experience from the Monitoring and Reporting 2023 and Member States' feedback received to date (MIG-T meeting, Geoportal helpdesk, Bilateral meetings).
- Procurement options are currently being explored.
