 - The Forum is still needed, but the scope should be modernised considering the new INSPIRE priorities and emerging technological trends. The currently existing technical solution (based on the ELGG web framework) is outdated and difficult to maintain for technical and security reasons.
 - To ensure long term sustainability:
 - Technical and legal questions around INSPIRE will be included in the future common INSPIRE Helpdesk hosted on GitHub
 - Discussions will be migrated to a new platform (e.g. GIS Stack Exchange with the use of INSPIREspecific tags)
 - The current content of the Community Forum will be archived for future use.
