### **Temporary Sub-group for Action 2.3.1**

- Issue
  - no clear governance process for the update, maintenance & evolution of INSPIRE artefacts (Technical Guidelines, application schemas, UML models, Good Practices)
  - change proposals submitted through different channels
  - unclear workflow for review and endorsement
- Scope
  - implement the governance approach for INSPIRE artefacts, presented by the JRC during the 64<sup>th</sup> MIG-T meeting (an update will be given tomorrow)
- Organisation setup
  - lead: JRC
  - support by: nominated technical experts from Member States, helpdesk facilitators, MIG, MIG-T, EC, EEA

### **Temporary Sub-group for Action 2.3.1**

- Tasks
  - organise GitHub repositories for INSPIRE artefacts
  - evaluate incoming change proposals
  - report to INSPIRE CT, MIG-T and MIG
  - integrate recommendations and update the artefacts
- Timeline
  - April 2021 December 2024
- Organisation setup
  - lead: JRC
  - support by: nominated technical experts, helpdesk facilitators, MIG, MIG-T, EC, EEA
