 - unclear workflow for review and endorsement

 - implement the governance approach for INSPIRE artefacts, presented by the JRC during the 64th MIG-T meeting (an update will be given tomorrow)

- Tasks
 - organise GitHub repositories for INSPIRE artefacts
 - evaluate incoming change proposals
 - report to INSPIRE CT, MIG-T and MIG
 - integrate recommendations and update the artefacts
- Timeline
 - April 2021 December 2024

 - support by: nominated technical experts, helpdesk facilitators, MIG, MIG-T, EC, EEA
