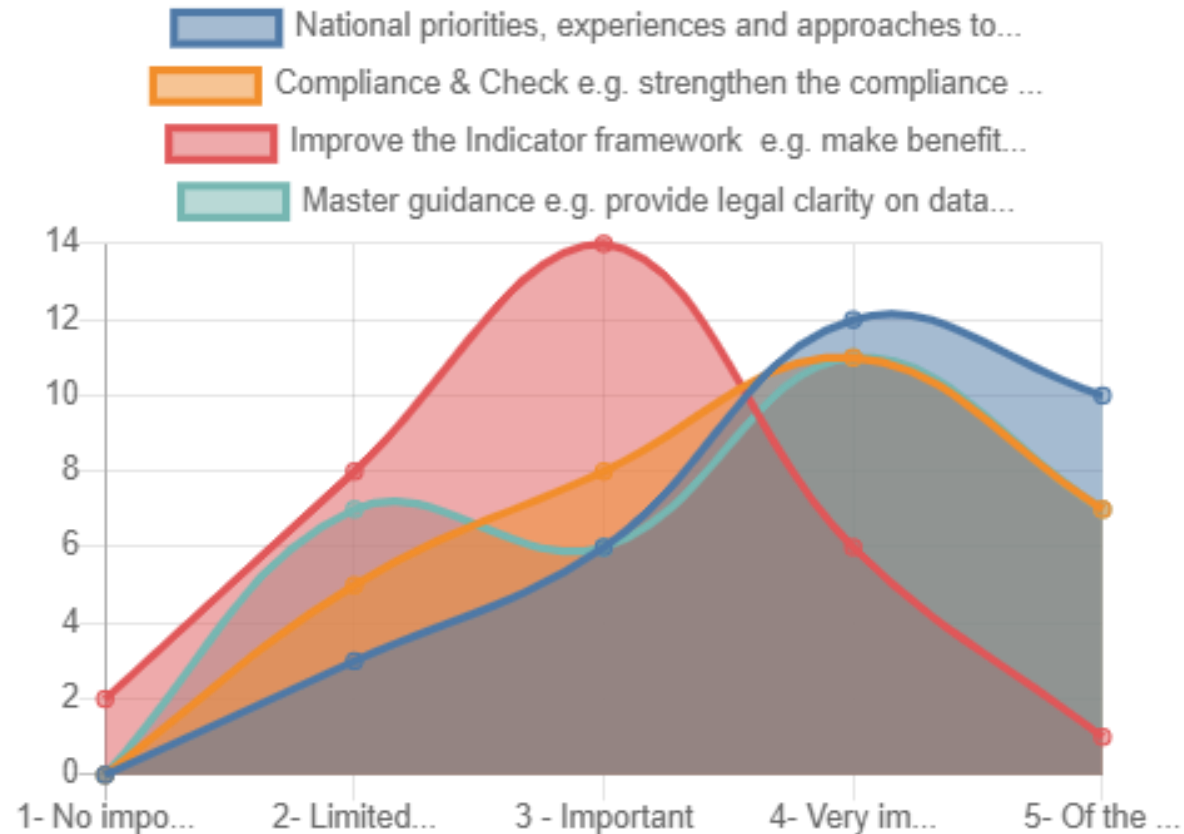

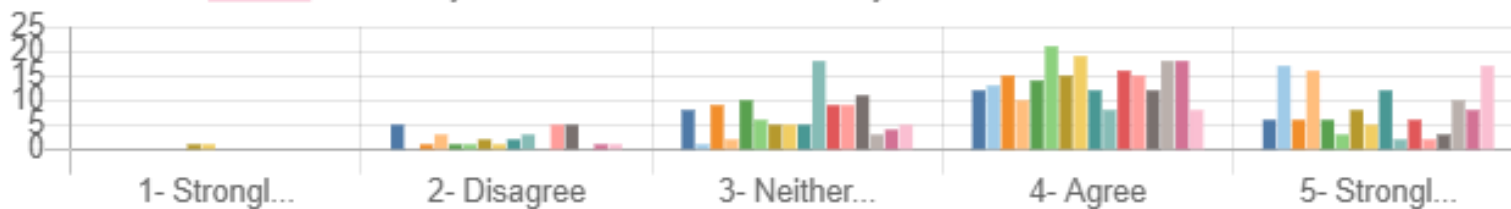

Getting started in MURAL ✕



Add elements

-  **Add sticky notes** by double clicking on the canvas
-  **Add text and other objects** by dragging them from the sidebar
-  **Add images** by dragging them in from your computer
-  **Add links and other files** by pasting them into the mural (Ctrl + V)

Edit elements

-  Double click Sticky Notes, Text Boxes and Titles to edit their text
-  Right click any element for more options

Navigate the mural

-  Use your mouse to zoom
-  Click and drag to move
