

- Land Administration Domain Models (LADM) ISO 19152:
 - Parts 1 to 6.
- Mechanism to harmonise Land cover and land use classifications ISO 19144:
 - Parts 1 to 4.

Advisory and ad-hoc groups

- Highlights:
 - AHG 05 on automated documentation.
 - AHG 07 on representing time "Time" is not specific to geographic information and good practice and standards for describing temporal aspects of data exist in many other areas.

 - Joint OGC and ISO/TC211 Code Sprint covering OGC API Records, ISO 19115, JSON-FG, and STAC.
- <u>December 2022</u>:
 Covering OGC API Maps, OGC API Tiles, OGC API Styles.




