
In this release, we introduced a new feature in eSubmission, where economic operators need to confirm now that the tender complies with the minimum requirements specified in the procurement documents.

Confirmation of compliance with the minimum requirements


During the submission of the tender (*open procedures, 2nd step of restricted procedures or design contests and negotiated procedures (any round)*), in the Tender Data section, tenderer needs to confirm that their tender complies with the minimum requirements specified in the procurement documents before being able to proceed to the next step. If the answer is "No", a text box will appear, in which the tenderer needs to enter an explanation. The chosen option (including the explanation, in case choosing "No"), will be reflected in the submission report (see [Quick Guide for economic operators](#)).




