For procedures with the best-price-quality ratio award method, tenderers need not encode the tender amount

As of 21st September 2022, tenderers will no longer be asked to enter the tender "Total amount" in eSubmission if the award method is **best price-quality ratio**.

In case of lowest price and lowest cost award method (where it remains a mandatory field for tenderers), the '**Total amount**' field will be displayed for all procedures.

The screenshot below displays how the Tender Data section will appear in eSubmission in case of best price-quality ratio award method.

Revamped <u>eSubmission quick guides</u> for all procurement procedures supported by eSubmission (open procedures, two-step procedures and negotiated procedures) are available in the Funding & Tenders Portal eProcurement wiki. The guides are available in all the 24 EU languages including Gaelic.
