SEDIA V3.5.0 is scheduled for release on 6 November 2020, in order to apply the following improvements and bug fixes:

Improvements

- Upgrade of the **homepage**:

Under EU Programmes, there is the **How to participate in 5 steps** section, in the centre of the page. It has a more visual layout, using numbers and better-structured information.

Finally, the **News** section has been moved to the top right corner of the page, increasing its visibility.
