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- PRIME as a platform will cooperate with
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- RU Dialogue to:
 - improve the performance of rail freight corridors,
 - usage of the language regime for train drivers
 - develop mutually useful Key Performance Indicators

Mandate for PRIME from 4RP



Article 7f of 4RP

Member States shall ensure that their main IMs participate and cooperate in a network that convenes at regular intervals to:

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- c) exchange best practices,
- d) monitor and benchmark performance,
- e) contribute to the market monitoring activities referred to in Article 15,
- f) tackle cross-border bottlenecks
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Sector statement: the joint IM-RUcustomers initiative

- Sector Statement on Rail Freight Corridors "Boosting International Rail Freight" presented at TEN-T Days in Rotterdam
- Sector initiative: rail associations representing IMs, RUs, combined transport, terminals, end customers, with support of RFCs
- Translated 1:1 into action list with selection of ten priority actions

Action list



- All actions grouped under six headings:
 - Governance and monitoring
 - Capacity planning and allocation
 - Operational harmonization
 - Infrastructure development and ERTMS
 - IT of operational information
 - Noise mitigation
- Clear reference to articles of Sector Statement and Ministerial Declaration



Priority actions - supported by RUD

Planning

- Timetable Redesign (TTR)
- Improvement of international freight capacity
- Coordination of Temp. Capacity Restrictions
- Enhancement of Path Coordination System

Operations

- Harmonisation of border-crossing sections
- Estimated Time of Arrival/Handover

Infrastructure investments

- TEN-T technical requirements = trains 750 m
- ERTMS deployment

Governance

- Performance KPIs
- Harmonisation of RFC documents



Proposal

Closer cooperation between RU-Dialogue and PRIME through:

- Joint RU Dialogue Plenary PRIME Plenary meetings at working level (similar to PRIME ENRRB) on annual basis
- Ad-hoc invitations to subgroup meetings for specific issues and if deemed necessary

Avoid duplication of work: cooperation will allow a more efficient problem solving approach

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
