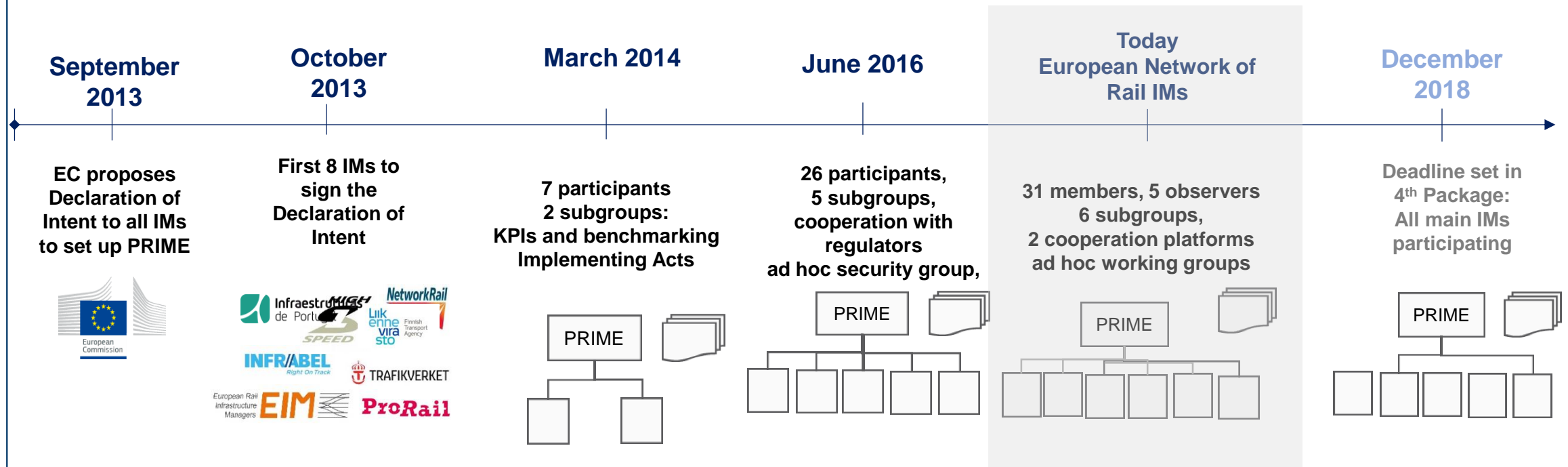
Main features

- Acts as **the European Network of Infrastructure Managers** as established by the 4th Railway Package
- The only platform allowing direct exchange between IMs and the EC, and co-chaired by both
- Allowing discussion of legislative initiatives at a very early stage
- Allowing all IMs to cooperate and establish common priorities
- Comprehensive scope encompasses all strategic (regulatory, operational and financial) aspects relevant for IMs

Added value

- ‘Influencing’ function: industry able to affect draft legislation
- ‘Early warning’ function: EC/ERA and industry - interaction and mutual understanding of respective ‘business’
- ‘Stress-test’ function: EC to test legislative proposals re their ‘implementability’
- ‘Learning’ function: EC and IM to improve ‘Business’ function: Benchmarking of best practice to enhance IMs effectiveness and capabilities

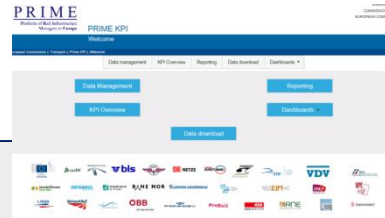
