History

- PRIME subgroup started in 2014
 - Network Rail chairman u/i 2017
 - ProRail chairman as of 2018
- 10-15 active members
- Initial goals:
 - Exchange of knowledge and best practices
 - Development of models and KPI's on near miss and safety conversations, eventually: European benchmark
- 2017: Twinning Program



Overall lessons from twinning program 2017

- 1. Many best practices and learning points for improvement per organization
 - No one size fits all, often need for tailoring
- 2. European IM's are different and hard to compare on safety culture
 - Different context: national culture, role NSA, role prosecutors, role government
 - Different organizations: culture, structure, responsibility for safety (line/staff), role and position of safety department
 - Different interfaces: contractors and railway undertakings
- 3. We can use models to measure safety culture per organization, but
 - We have no shared language, perception and definitions
 - Best to monitor development per organization, not to compare



Subgroup goals for 2018 and further

- Exchange knowledge and best practices
 - On measuring safety culture
 - On improving safety culture
- Support and organize in-depth learning from other organizations
- Meet 3x per year, make separate bilateral appointments



Main topics subgroup 2018 and further

- 1. Safety leadership (RSSB, Network Rail)
- 2. Promoting a learning culture, learn from things that went well (Infrabel, ProRail)
- 3. Rules (Infrabel, Irish Rail)
- 4. Serious gaming (ProRail, i.c.w. EUAR)
- 5. Twinning program 2019
