Working on RFC

PRIME and RUD will follow up the 10 priorities from the Sector Statement, with a particular focus on TTR and ETA

KPIs

Both PRIME and RUD work on KPIs and and will continue to well coordinate

Language regime

PRIME and RUD will work together on set up-a « card » of standard necessary messages drawing on work already ongoing in this area

Digitalisation

- Open data: a joint sub group will be created. PRIME should start working on this first and then invite RUD
- The railway sector should be represented at the Digital transport Days in Tallin, 8-10 septembre 2017
