	Landscape Factory was established through a Memorandum of Understanding.
	To achieve its goals, the founders attracted funding from more than 10 sources (more than EUR 433.000 since 2020) and cooperate with various other partner organisations (more than 60) at national and European level.
	At the European level, CoVE Romania Landscape Factory is part of the European Urban Greening Platform - a network that brings together similar centres from 5 other EU Member States.
	Objectives of Landscape Factory Romania:
	 To develop curriculum for initial and continuous training in the field of urban greening in Romania.
	 To develop guidance / support materials for urban greening activity in Romania, dedicated to professionals in the field, public authorities and VET schools.
	 To increase awareness regarding the field of urban greening in Romania.
	 To create learning opportunities and contexts for students, teachers and professionals in the field, including through the internationalisation in the field of urban greening

Key activities and outcomes

Main achievements:

- The Training Standard and curricula for the new qualification Urban Gardner is under development in cooperation with 5 VET schools of agriculture, 3 companies and one professional association.
 - Next step: adopting the new qualification in the educational offer of at least 3 schools.
- 3 weeks training for students on Urban Biodiversity, at Green Academy, Denmark. 25 students, EQF level 4.
- 1 week training course for VET teachers, on Teaching Urban Greening, at Green Academy, Denmark. 15 VET teachers from 6 schools.
 - Impact: 2 new teaching subjects on urban greening (EQF 3) dedicated to students of horticulture were developed and they have been implemented since Sept 2023.
- In the courtyard of Cezar Nicolau Technological High School, the first outdoor training area for urban greening is created. Students and adults training courses will be delivered there.
 - **4 new partners** were attracted in the creation of this space:
 - Ilfov County Council
 - Branesti Municipality (city hall)
 - World Vision Romania
 - Asociatia Centrul de Excelenta pentru Resurse Educationale Agro-Alimentare si Dezvoltare Durabila
