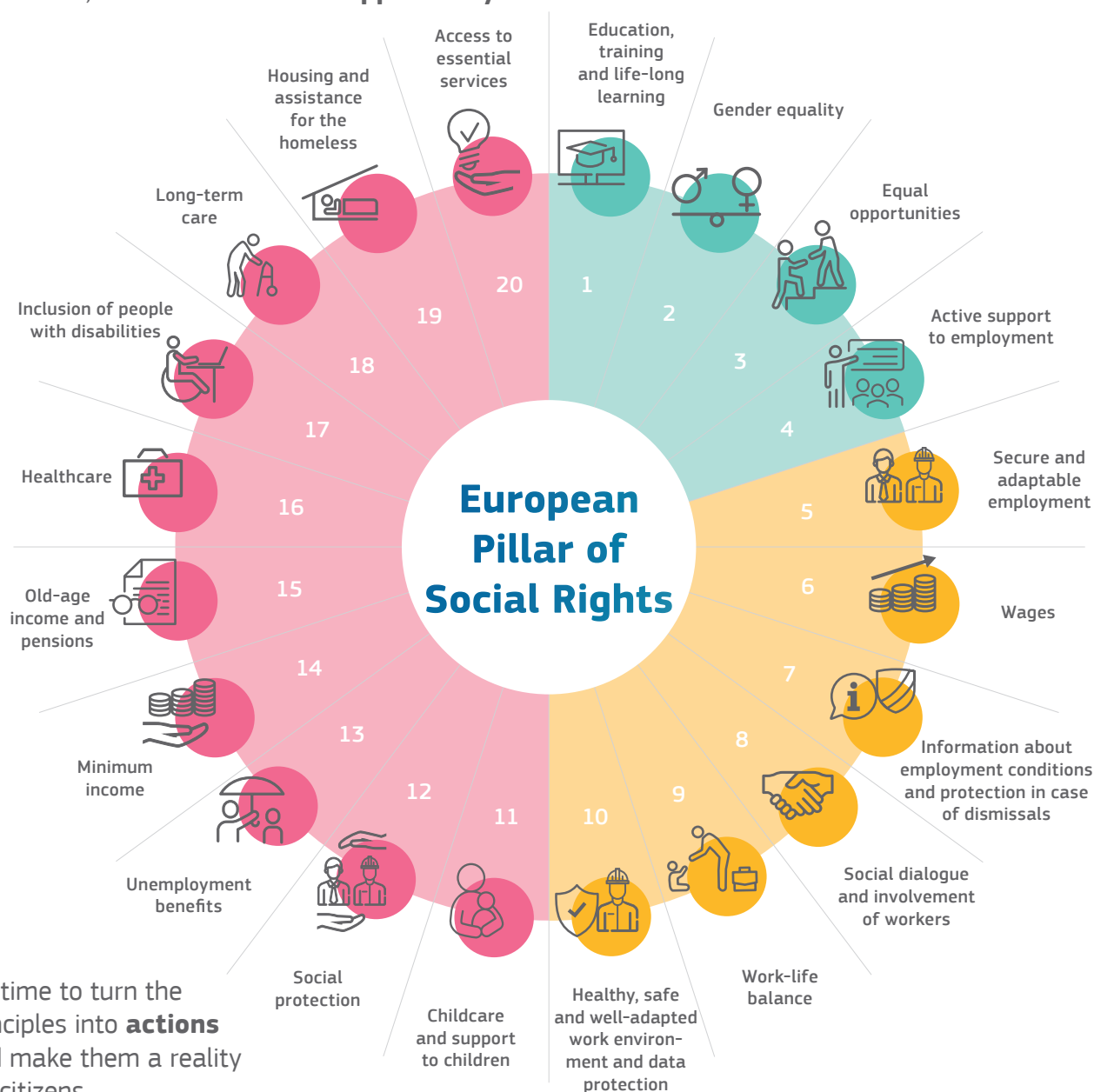

The 20 principles of the European Pillar of Social Rights guide us towards a **strong social Europe** that is **fair, inclusive** and full of **opportunity**.

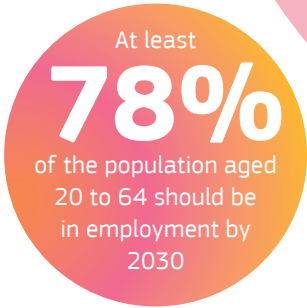

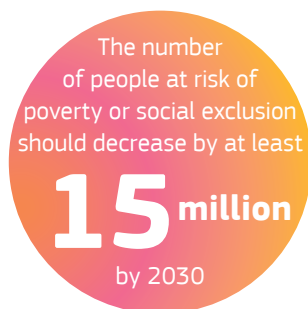
Skills and equality

...As well as ensuring that people have the **right skills** for those jobs and access to the right opportunities to match them



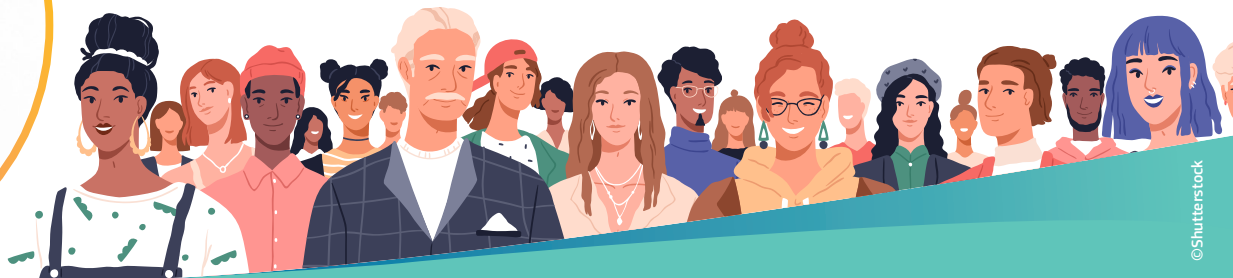
Social protection and inclusion
