GreenData4All

GreenData4All

INSPIRE as an enabler for the Green Deal dataspace

- Announced in the 2020 European Data Strategy.
- Better availability and accessibility of environmental data will help to deliver on EU Green deal strategies.
- INSPIRE Directive is an important instrument for bringing data from public administrations into the Green Deal data space
- **Evaluate the INSPIRE Directive** and look at the coherence with the public access to environmental information Directive 2003/4/EC - **Done**
- **Revision of the INSPIRE Directive – In preparation**

State of Play

- Call for Evidence detailing the problem definition and possible policy options for the Impact Assessment is still under preparation.
- Exploring and assessing the possible policy options for a soundly substantiated impact analysis takes more time
 - To fully exploit the opportunities of the new horizontal legal framework on digital data (Open Data Directive, Data Governance Act, Data Act,...) and non-legal initiatives (e.g. Digital Europe Programme Actions) on which it depends for its successful delivery.
 - To maximize coherence with the larger ecosystem of the European Common Dataspace and contribute to the development of a Green Deal data space
 - To increase the potential for broad data reuse while minimizing implementation burden and promoting the once-only principle.
- The overall timing of the GreenData4All initiative was reviewed with the following indicative roadmap:
 - Q2 2023: Call for Evidence for the Impact Assessment
 - Q2 2023- Q4 2023 Public consultation
 - Q2 2023–Q4 2024 Impact Assessment & study
 - Q2 2025 Legal proposal adopted by the College

Amending Commission Regulation 1089/2010

- Scrutiny by co-legislators ended on 7 February 2023
- Translation issues were reported by DE, RO, PL and CZ and new language versions were prepared by the Commission Translation Service.
- The amending act will now be proposed for adoption by the College of Commissioners.
- Adoption is expected for May 2023
