

EC branded core website design

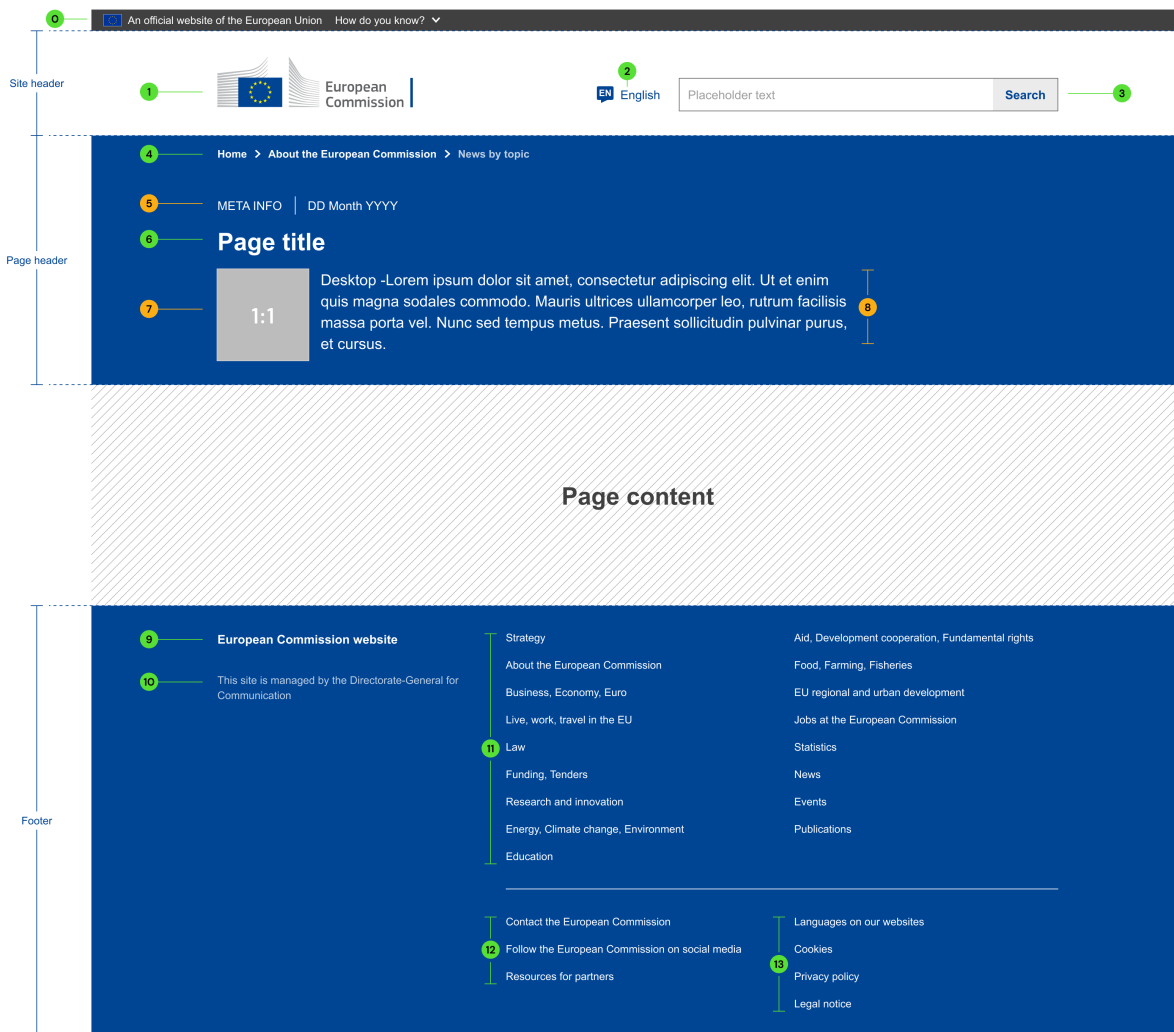
Definition
