This page explains how to add and edit information regarding the fewer opportunities encountered by certain participants to your granted projects for Erasmus+ Key Action 1 and European Solidarity Corps.

Due to data protection rules, any information regarding fewer opportunities encountered by participants must not be directly linked to a specific participant. Therefore if you have indicated that your project includes participants with fewer opportunities, you will have to provide an overview of the number of participants having fewer opportunities for various reasons. These specific details are not calculated automatically based on the information provided in the mobilities.

## **Information**

Fields may vary depending on the action type of you project. Please read the onscreen information carefully to complete the relevant fields.

# Prerequisites

- Only the contact person of the beneficiary organisation with edit rights on the project is able to perform these actions.
- A grant agreement has been signed for the project, and it is visible in **My projects**.
- To update the project it must have the status **Project Ongoing**.
- The project must include participants with fewer opportunities.

## Steps

### 1. Access "Fewer opportunities" in the Content menu

In your project, click on **Fewer opportunities** in the Content menu.

### 2. Type the number of participants matching each reason

#### Take note

All participants with fewer opportunities defined in the project should have a reason declared in the **Fewer opportunities** screen. For each participant please take into account only the main reason.

For each of the fewer opportunities reasons in the **Reasons** column, click in the corresponding field in the **Number of participants** column and type the desired number. If you need to remove a previously entered value, delete the value and type 0 in the field.


