In **KA151**, **KA152** and **KA153** projects (all calls), when creating or updating a mobility activity, the **Participant is from the receiving organisation** flag is displayed in the **Participant** section of the mobility activity details if the mobility activity is linked to an activity of type **Preparatory visit**.

Checking the flag indicates that the participant is from the **receiving organisation**. When the flag is checked, the **Preparatory Visit Support** (in the Budget section) is set to **0 EUR**.
