What are the population trends of pollinator species? What is the magnitude of pressures on pollinators?

While the current knowledge clearly demonstrates an alarming decline of pollinators and warrants immediate action, there are still significant data gaps that prevent effective conservation actions. In addition to existing processes (for example, reporting under the Habitats Directive), a number of **m onitoring initiatives** aim to fill gaps on the abundance and diversity of pollinator species, as well as on key pressures such as the loss/degradation of habitats, pesticides and other pollutants.
