Early results, ELISE Two experts researching topics around data-driven innovation within the context of the ELISE action of the ISA2 Pool of expert programme presented the current status of their work on: integration between authoritative geospatial datasets and datasets from the OpenStreetMap project, with first Integration between OpenStreetMap experiments on address data and interviews with some EU national mapping agencies; and INSPIRE the use of binary data serialisation, especially Protocol Buffers and Apache Avro, to encode geospatial data, with datasets experiments on both large geospatial data and geospatial data retrieved through APIs.
