
#### **OLS Contact**

It is necessary to indicate an associated person as OLS contact in the application form. The contact indicated as the Online Language Support contact receives a notification by email when licences for language assessments and language courses are available in the Online Language Support (OLS) system, and is responsible for sending invitations to mobility participants to take the language assessment and start the language course, if awarded. The Online Language Support contact person is also responsible for monitoring the usage of licences and can create additional Online Language Support users (aliases) with the same access rights if needed.
