The meeting was chaired by the JRC and attended by 61 experts from AT, BE, BG, CY, CZ, DE, DK, EE, ES, FI, HR, IS, IT, LI, LU, LV, MT, NL, NO, PL, PT, SE, SI, SK, the European Commission (ENV, JRC, ESTAT), and the European Environment Agency (EEA).

	<ul> <li>INSPIRE Registry and Re3gistry</li> <li>A new pre-release of the Re3gistry software - version v2.4.0-rc.1 - was delivered on 07 Oct 2022 and is ready for users testing. It includes minor bug-fixes and new features or enhancements, like the inclusion of an optional simplified workflow for managing the registry content, alternative to the one defined by ISO 19131. The definitive release - v2.4.0 - is expected during October 2022.</li> <li>Information on the helpdesk management workflow, and on the release strategy of the Re3gistry software (including related milestones), was summarised.</li> <li>The new INSPIRE Registry, based on Re3gistry software v2.3.1, is already online. The rollout successfully took place on 06 Oct 2022. Having completed this milestone, in the next months the workflow for managing change proposals to the content of the INSPIRE Registry, along with the activity of the Control Body, will be reactivated.</li> <li>A brief summary on the activities on community building around the Re3gistry software, the Registry Federation tool and the INSPIRE Registry was provided. To be highlighted:</li> <li>The Showcase on potential reuse of the Re3gistry by the European Union Publications Office and the European Commission Directorate General for Human Resources.</li> <li>Presentation on the Re3gistry software and the Register Federation Tool in the past FOSS4G Conference 2022, on 26 Aug 2022.</li> <li>Potential presentation on the Re3gistry software in the upcoming ENDORSE Conference 2023, to be held from 14 Mar 2023 to 16 Mar 2023.</li> <li>MIG-T members to promote testing of the pre-release of the Re3gistry software - version v2.4.0-rc.1</li> <li>MIG-T members to test the new INSPIRE Registry and report back any issues encountered through the corresponding helpdesk.</li> </ul>

INSPIRE M&R 2022 • M&R 2022 recap • Geoportal Infrastructure • GeoNetwork Backend • Beta	<ul> <li>M&amp;R 2022 recap</li> <li>The INSPIRE M&amp;R 2022 will be run in an automated way starting from 16 Dec 2022 and following the usual procedure, with 19 indicators calculated using the INSPIRE Geoportal and the INSPIRE Reference Validator.</li> <li>Operators of national discovery services, in light of the forthcoming M&amp;R exercise, should start testing the new INSPIRE Geoportal backend infrastructure at the earliest possible.</li> <li>Geoportal Infrastructure</li> <li>Update on the project for the INSPIRE Geoportal revamp, including an overview of the beta-testing of the new GeoNetwork backend, initiated during the 70th MIG-T Meeting held on 07 Jul 2022.</li> <li>The preparation for the beta-testing process included a 1st training session for MS / EFTA countries on the use of the new backend, held on 15 Jul 2022, along with the opening of an ad-hoc online survey on 22 Jul 2022 for providing feedback on the user experience and a first evaluation of this new software component. The survey remained open until 15 Oct 2022 for those MS still willing to contribute.</li> <li>A 2nd training Q/A session for MS / EFTA countries was organised on 05 Oct 2022 for presenting the preliminary results of the beta-testing process while allowing MS to provide direct feedback on the coll.</li> <li>An overview of the preliminary results of the beta-testing was provided, including:</li> <ul> <li>A comparison of the main Geoportal indicators obtained for all national endpoints through using both the current INSPIRE Geoportal harvesting console and the new GeoNetwork backend.</li> <li>A cable with the jobal evaluation provided by 10 MS / EFTA countries (AT, BE, DE, EL, FI, HR, NL, PL, PT, SK) in the survey, representing the 59% of them, which in general shows similar or better results in terms of functionality, usability, performance and improvement of the new GeoNetwork backend.</li> <li>The revamped INSPIRE Geoportal will be used in the forthcoming M&amp;R exercise, at the end of 2022.</li> <li>MIG-T members are encouraged to engage re</li></ul></ul>
