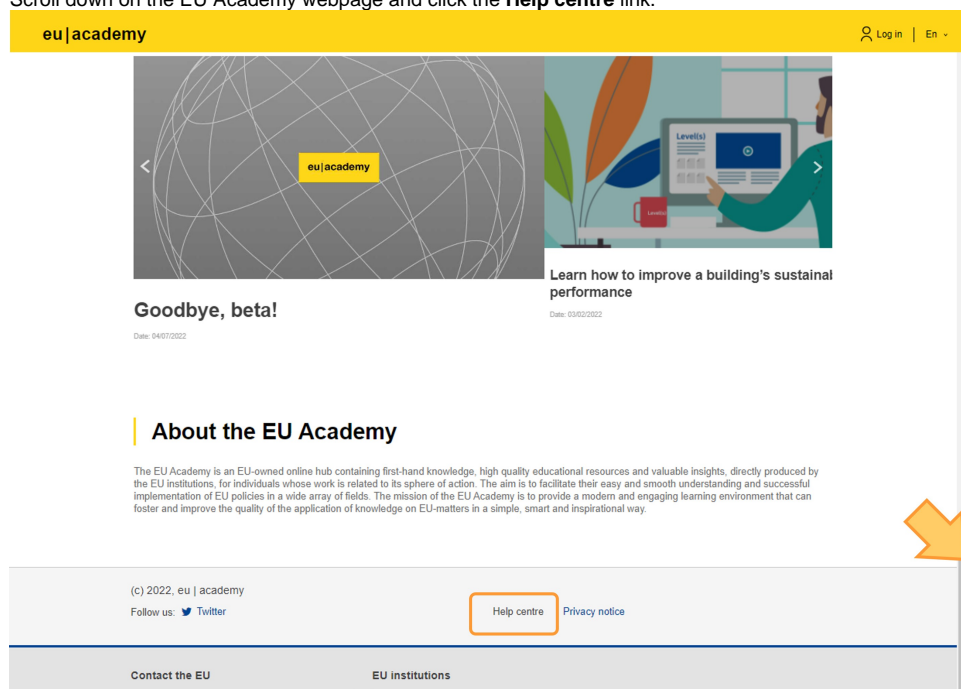

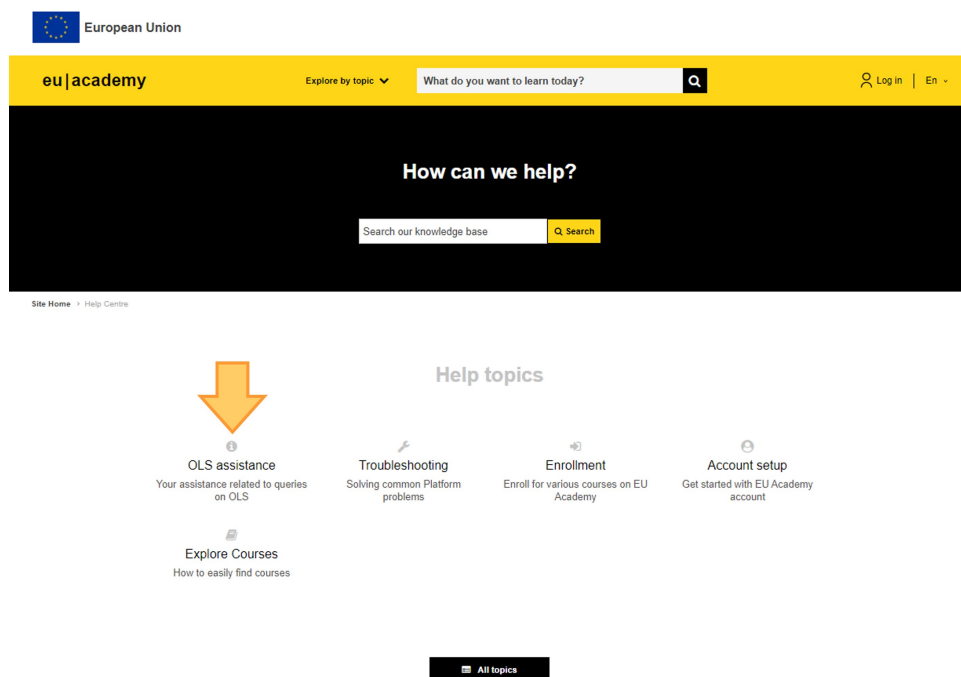
OLS Support
